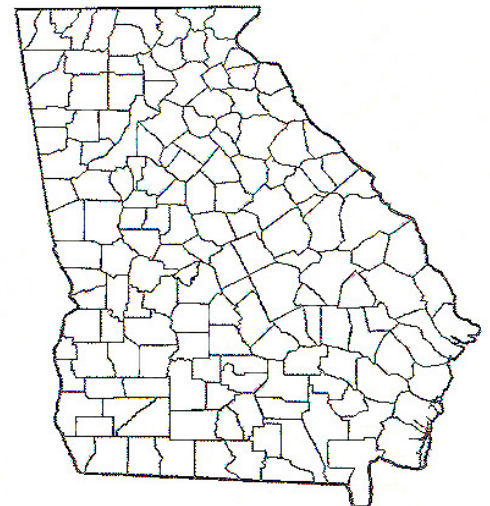
Would you like to be a direct, personal, & dynamic link between academic teaching and research and the people of Georgia?
