

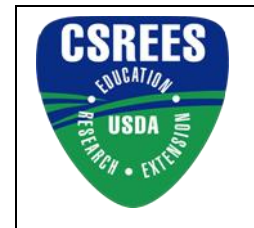

WHAT: FIVE College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences Multicultural Scholarships.

AMOUNT: Up to \$6,000/year for 4 years

WHEN: Scholarships are available for **FALL 2009**

Five scholarships are available for first year minority students pursuing majors in the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences at the University of Georgia. Eligible majors are listed on the attached sheet.



REQUIREMENTS:

- Successful applicants must enroll in a food or agriculture-related discipline in the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences to receive and maintain scholarship funds.
- Students must maintain a 3.0 grade point average.
- Students must participate in the CAES Multicultural Scholarship Program that involves peer and faculty mentorship, leadership development, service learning, study abroad, undergraduate research, an internship and continued membership in the UGA chapter of Minorities in Agriculture, Natural Resources and Related Sciences (MANRRS).

APPLICATION PROCESS: Awardees must be highly competitive and selection will be based on:

1. SAT scores
2. Projected grade point average
3. Letters of reference (2 letters required)
4. Interview
5. Application essays

Applications will be available at <http://www.caes.uga.edu/academics/> starting Feb. 15 and will require an essay describing your understanding of agricultural, food and environmental sciences, why they are important, why you are interested in pursuing your chosen major and what unique qualifications you will bring to your field of study.

Application deadline: April 6, 2009

Interviews: April 11, 2009

Award notification will be distributed by April 15, 2009
