Rock Eagle is located in Eatonton, Georgia, approximately 2 hours from Canton.

There is nightly entertainment too. A Monday night skit, a talent show, campfires, cookout, slide show of our week and fantastic games and dances. This week is packed with fun, but know it is very challenging with nonstop activities. **You don't want to miss this fun filled week.**
