**WHAT: 4-H Project Achievement Competition**

**WHEN: February 17-18, 2012 (overnight trip)**

**WHERE: Rock Eagle 4-H Center in Eatonton, Georgia**

**Cost: \$30.00 plus money for canteen/souvenirs**



The time is fast approaching for 4-H Project Achievement. This is an educational competition for our 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade 4-H students. Students must prepare a 6 minute presentation on a subject of their choice. They will compete against other 5/6<sup>th</sup> graders. They can use any type of visual, (posters, models, etc.) providing it complies with school rules and a student can transport during the weekend. Students will present their demonstration in front of two judges. The categories to choose from are listed on the back of this letter. In order to reserve a category, a **parent** must call the Extension office at (770)479-0418. Only two students can enter each category, so call early to get your first choice. Please print and complete the 4-H health form, code of conduct, and worksheet from our website links and return forms and check made to Cherokee County 4-H, 100 North Street G-21, Canton, GA 30114, not your school; Deadline Jan 15<sup>th</sup>.
