BLUEBERRY BUSHES

COST- \$13.00

3 gallon pot

Blueberries are pest free and require little care once established. The average family needs 4 - 6 bushes. You can plant as few as 2 bushes but must have 2 different varieties for pollination. They produce best in full sun. You can plant them as close as 4 - 6 feet apart for a hedge effect or 10 feet apart for maximum fruit production. These plants are 1 - 2 ft. tall. Information on varieties is available upon request. Varieties:

Premier	Early Season - (starts ripening in mid- late June)
Powderblue	Mid-Season - (usually ripens in early – mid July)
Tiftblue	Late Season – (mid July until August)

GRAPE MYRTLES

COST - \$5.00

1 gallon pot

These "improved varieties" of Grape Myrtles are releases from the U.S. Arboretum and they have a high resistance to powdery mildew disease. These are in one gallon pots and grow rapidly. In addition to the beautiful blooms in summer this small tree is prized for its yellow – orange fall leaf color and exfoliating bark. Bark under tones can vary from brown to russet.

Varieties:

Natchez	- color of bloom white, burgundy under bark. (20 – 30' tall)
Pink Velour	- Pink blossoms and burgundy foliage on new growth (15' tall)
Tuscarora	- color of bloom - watermelon (20 – 25' tall)
Arapaho	- color of bloom – red (20+ tall)
Sioux	- color of bloom - light pink bloom (15' tall) (1996 Gold Medal Plant)

PERENNIALS/ GROUNDCOVERS

Gold Mound Spirea - 1 gallon, Mounding, leaves are yellow green turning a golden color in summer. The mature plant will become 2 -3 ft. tall. Pink flowers. **Cost - \$5.00**

Tassel Fern (*Polystichum polylepharum*) – 1 gallon pot. Has the shiniest foliage of all the ornamental ferns, as if a waxy coating had been brushed upon its lacy fronds. It is usually evergreen. Like most ferns, Japanese tassel fern needs at least light shade and will do fine in full shade. Up to 3 ft. tall. Creeping, crown forming rhizome; very easy to grow. **Cost - \$6.00**

Autumn Fern (*Dryopteris erythrosora*) – 1 gallon pot Height 18 – 24", foliage color changes with season. Scarlet spores adorn undersides of the fronds. New growth emerges metallic coppery green, turns green in summer and bronzy in fall. Grows best in shade and moist soil. **2001 Gold Medal Plant** **Cost – \$6.00**

Coreopsis 'Early Sunrise'- 1 gallon, golden - yellow double blossom. Blooms early summer thru fall. Deer and drought resistant. Dead heading lengthens bloom period. Works great for borders at 20 – 24 inches and can be divided every 2 -3 years. **Cost - \$6.00**

Helleborus-Red Lady- 1 gallon, up facing deep red flowers cluster above the glossy, leathery deep green leaves. An excellent companion for Hostas in a shade or woodland garden. Evergreen. 2005 Perennial Plant of the Year. **Cost - \$8.00**

Helleborus-Pink Lady- 1 gallon, up facing white flowers blushed with pink cluster above the glossy, leathery deep green leaves. An excellent companion for Hostas in a shade or woodland garden. Evergreen. 2005 Perennial Plant of the Year. **Cost - \$8.00**

FLOWERING SHRUBS

Loropetalum 'Ruby' – 1 gallon. Arching habit, with light burgundy to olive green leaves. Prefers full sun to light shade. Grows 5 - 6ft tall. Brilliant hot pink confetti like flowers periodically thru year. **Cost- \$6.00**

Loropetalum 'Sizzling Pink'-1 gallon. Clusters of rich, pink fringed flowers repeat throughout the year. Showy new growth is deep burgundy remaining purple tinged all year. **Cost - \$6.00**

Viburnum 'Summer Snowflake' –(Viburnum plicatum var. tomentosum)- 1 gallon, dark green leaves with nice burgundy fall color, white blooms in late spring, grows 6 -8 ft. tall. Deciduous. 2004 Gold Medal Plant. **Cost - \$7.00**

Viburnum 'Mohawk'- 1 gallon, Glossy, dark red flower buds are ornamental for several weeks before opening in late April to reveal waxy white flowers. The dark green leaves of this deciduous shrub turn a brilliant orange-red in autumn. Resistance to bacterial leaf spot and powdery mildew round out the checklist of outstanding qualities **Cost - \$7.00**

Knock Out Rose - Double Red, 5 gallon plant, one of the finest landscape roses ever tested; almost resistant to black spot, the fungal disease that is the scourge of roses, also resistant to powdery mildew and aphids. It is cold-hardy throughout the state. Locate the plants where they will get good air movement over the leaves and receive eight hours or more of direct sun each day **Cost –\$16.00**

Knock Out Rose – Blushing, 5 gallon plant - tough and hardy shrub type rose with outstanding disease resistance. Blooms are light pink gradually changing to shell pink as the bloom ages. Leaves are a mossy green with blue hues. Blooms early spring and continues blooming until the first hard frost in the fall. Drought tolerant, Black spot resistant, mildew tolerant and self-cleaning. An excellent choice for a trouble free rose garden, hedge, border or foundation planting. **Cost - \$16.00**

Gardenia 'Frostproof' -1 gallon, this plant won the "2007 Garden Writers Best Plant Award." It blooms into velvety white fragrant flowers in late spring and continues through summer. It will be 3-4 foot tall. Prefers full or partial sun **Cost - \$6.00**

Azalea (Deciduous) 'Admiral Semmes'- 2 gallon, the plant bears beautiful medium yellow-flowers with deeper dorsal flares and pleasing fragrance in May. Very lustrous dark green leaves turn orange-bronze in fall. The handsome leaves are exceptionally mildew free. **Cost - \$10.00**

Azalea 'Lisa's Gold'-3 gallon, this hybrid bears fragrant gold flowers in early spring. The loose, multi-stemmed shrub grows to 10-12' high. **Cost - \$13.00**
