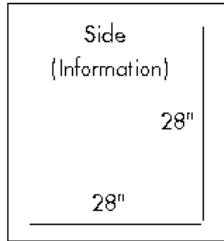
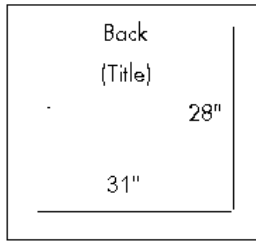
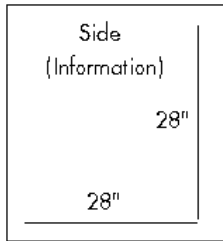

Important Mini-booth Dates to Remember

Thursday, September 1—Sign-up Begins

Monday, October 3—Sign-up Deadline

Saturday, October 15—Enter mini-booths from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Waiting list enter booths from 2:00-3:00 p.m. as available.

October 17-22—Go to the fair and have fun!

Sunday, October 23—Remove all mini-booths from 2:00-4:00 p.m.



A Marvelous Mini-Booth is...

- ☺ **Fun**—you can do your mini-booth display on anything that interests YOU! Have fun with it!
- ☺ **Educational**—Make sure all information is correct and up-to-date
- ☺ **Well-planned**—A well-planned booth will be easier to make. Try sketching out your booth on paper before you begin. Make sure your booth gets your point across, has correct and up-to-date information, and is interesting!
- ☺ **Neat**—Use three sheets of posterboard to design your mini-booth, these will be stapled to the covered wooden booth at the fair. Cut-out or computer generated letters look best. Be sure to check for spelling errors!
- ☺ **Easy to Read**—Make sure all letters are at least one inch high. Titles and headings will be larger.
- ☺ **Eye Catching**—Be sure to use colors that compliment each other and help your words stand out (ex.—dark letters on light paper or light letters on dark paper).
- ☺ **Has a Theme**—Choose a simple theme and stick to that idea! A catchy title helps too!
- ☺ **Has a Floor Display**—Be creative! For your floor display you can use something unique such as sand, straw, or fabric. Do not use anything valuable...we will not be responsible for items in mini-booths!

Rules For Entering Your Marvelous Mini-Booth:

- ⌘ All work must be the work of the exhibitor.
- ⌘ All booths must have been prepared since the previous fair.
- ⌘ You must sign up with the 4-H office **BEFORE** entering your mini-booth at the fair!
- ⌘ All mini-booths will be entered on a first-come, first-serve basis. Booths are located in the 4-H Building on the Kiwanis Ogeechee Fairgrounds.
- ⌘ Booths can be entered on Saturday, Oct 15 from 9:00 am-2:00 pm. Those on the waiting list can enter their mini-booths from 2:00-3:00 p.m.
- ⌘ Mini-booths must conform to the space allowed. The space will be 28" deep, 31" wide, and 28" high.
- ⌘ Booths will be judged before the fair opens on Monday.
- ⌘ Mini-booths must be removed on Sunday, October 23, from 2:00-4:00 p.m.
- ⌘ The Kiwanis Club will not be responsible for any items in the booths, however wiring will be put over your booth to protect contents.
- ⌘ **IMPORTANT:** 4-H'ers that have been given a mini-booth space have until Saturday at 2:00 p.m. to enter their booth. After 2:00 p.m. any Bulloch County booth that has not been filled will be given out to 4-H'ers on the waiting list.
- ⌘ 4-H'ers on the waiting list may come and enter their completed booths at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday.
- ⌘ Please bring a **HEAVY DUTY** staple gun and staples to put your mini-booth up with!
