General Information about Bulloch County 4-H

- ◆ 1,454 students enrolled
- ◆ 73 monthly 4-H meetings in Bulloch County
- ◆ 201 youth involved in Project Achievement
- ◆ 200 youth and volunteers attend 4-H Camp, 18 were at-risk youth scholarships.
- ◆ 93 entered a mini-booth in the fair
- ◆ 25 youth involved in Horse Events
- ◆ 51 youth involved in Project SAFE
- ◆ Shotgun team events
- ◆ 14 youth involved in Project SAFE
- ◆ Archery team events.
- ◆ 6 college scholarships were given totaling \$2,200.
- ◆ Over 10,000 items have been collected and distributed to organizations such as the Food Bank, the Animal Shelter, area nursing homes, and Red Cross.
- ◆ Coin drives in 4-H club meetings generated over \$4,000 for UNICEF and Relay for Life last year.



Curriculum

- ◆ 5th grade in-school curriculum is centered around English-Language Arts Georgia Performance Standards. 5th graders are learning writing and public speaking skills through a state-wide curriculum called, "Get Your Game on With 4-H!" This curriculum team was chaired by Lee Anna Deal, Bulloch County 4-H Agent.
- ◆ 6th grade in-school curriculum meets Social Studies Georgia Performance Standards in the area of Economics. 6th graders are learning financial literacy skills through UGA's "Your Money, Your Future" curriculum.
- ◆ Other curriculum available through 4-H:
 - "Wash Your Paws, Georgia!" A hand-washing curriculum being used at Portal Elementary School.
 - Georgia 4-H Agriscience Curriculum
 - Georgia 4-H Nutrition and Healthy Lifestyles Curriculum
 - Drought in Georgia Watersmart
 - Investigation H2O

Program Accomplishments

- ◆ 98% of youth involved in 4-H during their high school years graduate from high school.
- ◆ Bulloch County camped the 2nd Most Cloverleaf 4-H'ers in the State.
- ◆ Bulloch County 4-H had the State Winning Junior Shotgun Team and the 2nd place State Junior Trap and Skeet Team.
- ◆ Walker Blitch, Bulloch County 4-H'er placed 1st in the State in the Trap and Skeet Competition.
- ◆ Two members of the 4-H Novice Archery Team excelled at State. Michael Klumpp, student at PES, was named the 5th High Individual in the State. Amy Cooper, student at BES, was named the 2nd High Individual in the State.
- ◆ We have one of the top Horse Drill Teams in the State.
- ◆ Lee Anna Deal, Bulloch County 4-H Agent, was named as one of four William H. Booth Award winners in the state for outstanding work with the Georgia 4-H program.
