The Georgia Department of Agriculture has commissioned the Agricultural Commodity Commission for Equine to submit a photo to be displayed in the Agriculture building located on Martin Luther King Jr. Drive in Atlanta as part of a face lift for the building.

The Agricultural Commodity Commission for Equine has offered this opportunity to Georgia 4-H'ers to select a photo to be displayed at the Georgia Department of Agriculture Building.

Rules and Regulations

- 1) Photos must be taken by 4-H'er 18 years or younger. 4-H'er cannot have passed their 18th birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
- 2) Photos must NOT have a human as part of the photo
- 3) Photos may have horses displayed with any other animal vegetable or mineral
- 4) ***Only digital photo submissions will be accepted.***
- 5) Photos must be submitted to the following specifications:
 - Use a digital camera with at least 8 megapixels or greater, which is now very common, you'll need at least 220 pixel per square inch.
 - Photos can be either "black & white" or "color"
 - Using most modern digital cameras, the default or normal setting will allow you to shoot at the correct setting for a clear 8 x 10 or 11 x 14 photograph with good lighting. Using the manual setting on a digital camera, you'll set the camera to its highest or mid-range setting of 1600x1200 megapixels but generally the default setting will allow you to print 8 x 10 or 11 x 14.
- 6) Photos must be emailed to Lindsey Fodor, fodor@uga.edu or lindsey.fodor@gmail.com, at the State 4-H Office by the close of business **Wednesday October 26th.**
- 7) ***One entry per person***
