## Training for Pesticide Applicators

Commercial pesticide applicators licensed in categories 21 (Plant Ag) and 24 (Ornamentals & Turf) can receive 5 credit hours. All other categories and private applicators can receive 2 hours credit. Credit hours will NOT be offered for structural categories 28, 29, or 30.

Participants have to attend 5 hours of the training to get 5 hours credit or 2 hours to get 2 hours credit.

The morning session is targeted toward row crops and tree fruit. The late afternoon session is targeted toward Ornamentals and Turf. The middle session of the day (after lunch) will be of interest to nearly any category including pesticide safety, water issues, regulatory issues, and legislative updates.
