



**Summer 4-H Camp**  
 Burton 4-H Center on Tybee Island  
 June 6–10, 2011



One of the highlights of our year is the week of 4-H summer camp. We are delighted that we have the rare opportunity to attend camp next summer at Burton 4-H Center located on Tybee Island. 4-H summer camp is a week-long resident camp filled with educational and recreational activities. All activities are led by the counselor staff assisted by adults from our county. The counselors are college students who have passed a rigorous selection process and completed training for their assignments. Additionally all counselors are certified in first aid and safety. Chaperones for camp are adults from the county who have been approved by the University of Georgia background screening process and completed required chaperone training.



Athens-Clarke County Cloverleaves will be attending camp the week of **June 6 – 10, 2011**. The final cost of camp has not been determined due to the added cost of transportation for this distance. At this time we are estimating that the cost of camp will be **\$330** for the week. The cost of camp covers all fees and materials including transportation to and from camp, lodging, meals, dolphin cruise, program supplies, etc. For your convenience we have established an installment payment plan. An initial deposit of **\$85** will be due with your application on the camp sign up date, **February 17, 2011**. The remainder will be divided between 3 payments, due in March, April, and May.

Further information including the exact cost of camp and time for camp sign up will be provided along with the camp application form at the February 4-H club meeting or may be obtained at the 4-H office after **February 1, 2011**.

As a reward for participation, students who compete in the District Project Achievement competition at Rock Eagle on February 12, 2011 may register early for camp February 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>.

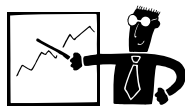

4. Have FUN! Be as creative as you can!

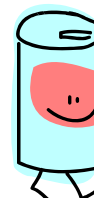


Posters will be judged on Creativity, Accuracy of Information, and Visual Appeal. It is important to submit the poster to your teacher before December 10th.
