## Forestry Judging

Forestry is one of the larger industries in the state of Georgia contributing \$20 billion annually to our state's economy. Participation in 4-H Forestry Judging will give students an understanding of the importance of our forest resources and an appreciation of the value to our state's economy. There are several components of the competition. Students will learn to identify trees native to our area primarily by looking at leaf samples and to identify insects and diseases which are harmful to the forest. They will also learn orienteering and to estimate timber harvest from select trees.



Forestry Judging practices will begin on Wednesday, May 26 from 10:00 AM until NOON. Practices will be held throughout the summer vacation and after school prior to the competition. The practice schedule for this event will be available on May 26. Forestry Field Day competition will be on Thursday, September 9th at the Wahsega 4-H Center.
