## Soil & Water Conservation Poster Contest

The Oconee River Soil and Water Conservation District Poster contest is open to all 5th grade students in Barrow, Clarke, Jackson, and Oconee Counties. The theme for the 2009 poster contest is:

“Dig It! The Secrets of Soil”. Students wishing to enter should create a poster with a message which will conform to this year’s theme.

Any artistic media may be used for the design (paint, crayon, colored pencil, collage, etc.). Posters must be between the sizes of 8.5” x 11” and 22” x 28”. Regular poster size (22 x 28) is preferred. Posters must be submitted to the 4-H office by Friday, April 17th.



Posters are evaluated on the following criteria:  
 Conservation Message - 50%  
 Visual Effectiveness - 30%  
 Originality - 10 %  
 Universal Appeal - 10%

## Conservation Photography Contest

The Oconee River Soil & Water Conservation District will also sponsor a photo contest open to ALL AGES. The theme of your photo entry must be related to Soil Conservation. Photos must be no larger than 8” x 10” and cannot be digitally altered in any way other than cropping. Each photo must be submitted with a 3” x 5” card with the following information:

1. Photographer’s name, address, and phone number
2. Age if under 18
3. Title of photograph
4. Subject (include names for each person in the photo)
5. Location
6. Description
7. Date photo was taken



All entries must be submitted to the 4-H office no later than 4:00 pm Friday, April 17, 2009. All entries become the property of the Oconee River Soil & Water Conservation District and will not be returned.

*Are you looking for something fun to do this summer? If so, no matter what grade you’re in, Athens-Clarke County 4-H has a Summer Camp for you!*

**Cloverleaf 4-H’ers (5th & 6th graders):** Cloverleaf Camp will take place June 8-12, 2009 at Rock Eagle 4-H Center. Sign-up for this camp will be **February 26th, from 4:00 pm - 5:30 pm** at the 4-H Office. Total camp cost is \$275.00 and an \$80.00 deposit is due on February 26th.

**Junior 4-H’ers (7th & 8th graders):** There are two camping opportunities for Junior 4-H’ers. Junior 4-H Camp at Camp Fortson in Hampton, GA is June 1-5, 2009. The second camp is Marine Resource Camp at Jekyll Island 4-H Center at Jekyll Island, GA during the week of July 6-10, 2009. Cost for each of these two camps is \$300.00 with a \$100.00 deposit due at sign-up on **February 19, 2009**.

**Senior 4-H’ers (9th -12th graders):** Senior Camp will take place at Wahsega 4-H Center in Dahlonega, GA during the week of June 29 - July 3, 2009. Cost for this camp is \$275.00, with a \$75.00 deposit due at sign-up on January 29, 2009.
