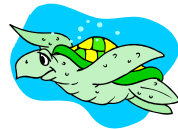
Burton 4-H Center on Tybee Island

Spend the week of June 6-10 at the beach with Athens-Clarke County 4-H! Cloverleaf Camp this year will be at Burton 4-H Center on Tybee Island. Tybee Island is located on the coast near historic Savannah, Ga. Your week of camp will be an awesome experience, packed full of things that you can't do every day or even on a normal family vacation trip to the beach. You'll get to experience the salt water marsh, learn about the animals that live along the coast, go on a boat ride to watch dolphins, fun recreation activities with your friends as well as daily trips to the beach.

The cost of camp will cover all fees and materials including transportation, lodging, meals, program supplies, and the dolphin cruise. The cost for camp this year is \$330. An initial deposit of \$85 must be submitted with the camp application and the balance will be divided between 3 payments, due in March, April, and May.

The date and time for camp sign up is **Thursday, February 17th beginning at 3:30 PM**. As a reward for participation, students who compete in the District Project Achievement Competition at Rock Eagle on February 12, 2011 may register for camp on Feb. 15th and 16th.

Soil and Water Conservation Poster Contest

Athens-Clarke County 4-H is offering a Soil and Water Conservation Poster Contest to all 5th graders. The theme for this contest is: **"Forests for People: More than You Can Imagine"**. Any artistic media may be used for the design (paint, crayon, colored pencil, collage, etc.). Posters must be between the sizes of 8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28". Regular poster size (22 x 28) is preferred. Posters must be submitted to the 4-H office by Friday, April 15th.

Conservation Message: 50% Visual Effectiveness: 30%
Originality: 10% Universal Appeal: 10%

Burton 4-H Center has been the home for Clover the sea turtle since August 13, 2008. Clover was a straggler – a hatchling who didn't make it out of the nest and to the ocean with her siblings. The staff at Burton received the tiny turtle on this day and has cared for her for over 2 years. Weighing only a few grams at birth, Clover now weighs over 15 pounds and measures 39.5 centimeters. Clover is doing well and growing steadily and is scheduled to be released in August 2011. To learn more about sea turtles, Clover's team of handlers are trying to raise money to have her fitted with a transmitter when she is released.
