BLACKBERRY Cost \$ 5.00 1 gal. size
 Bushes are self-fruitful. They yield more in full sun but will tolerate some shade. Blackberries are relatively pest free and require little care once established and are not as aggressive as their wild cousins. Expect yields up to 3-4 pints per plant. We offer: Fewer thorns: Arapaho; Navaho; Thorny: Kiowa



CHRYSANTHA-EDGEWORTHIA Cost \$ 12.00 1 gal. size
 The "Paperbush" is a very unusual and uncommon Daphne relative that bears white to bright yellow flowers on bare stems in winter. It is a semi shade plant and grows to 5 feet.

BLUEBERRY Cost \$ 10.00 2-3 gal. size
 Bushes prefer full sun, but tolerate some shade. They are relatively pest free and require little care once established. Plant at least two bushes, each a different variety for cross-pollination.

Varieties available:

Early Season: Climax; Brightwell; Premier; Austin;

Mid Season: Bluebell; Tifblue; Powder Blue;

Late Season: Centurion; Ochlocknee (OCHL. HAS 100 AVAIL)



CRAPE MYRTLES Cost \$ 5.00 1 gal. size
 Plants with distinctive exfoliating bark, are improved releases from the US Arboretum and have a high resistance to powdery mildew disease. Plants are approximately one foot tall and will grow to 10 to 20 feet depending on the variety. We offer: Arapaho (deep pink); Catawba (violet); Natchez (white); Pink Velour (bright pink); Sioux (Light pink)



RASPBERRY Cost \$ 5.00 1 gal. size
 Follow the same culture as blackberries except these are fall bearing and easier to maintain. The variety is Heritage.



HEUCHERAS Cost \$6.00 1 gal. size
 are perennials with striking foliage and textures.

Carmel—fuzzy glowing apricot foliage and purple-red undersides, pinky-cream flowers midsummer.

Raspberry Ice—pink and dark pink two-toned flowers over raspberry and frosty silver foliage.

Snow Angel—light green marble foliage with spider web variations



New! HELLEBORES Cost \$ 10.00 1 gal. size
 This vegetatively propagated hybrid, requires a moist, shaded site.

WHITE SPOTTED LADY—creamy white flowers and leathery evergreen foliage. ONLY 100 AVAILABLE.

RED LADY— Red flowers with thick, leathery, dark green leaves. ONLY 200 AVAILABLE. First come, first served.

VIBURNUM - Spring Bouquet Cost \$6.00 1 Gallon Size

A hardy evergreen bushy shrub, reaching around 5 feet high, 6 feet wide. It has clusters of sweet smelling white or pink-tinged flowers which appear any time from November to February, depending on weather conditions. These are followed by pink berries which ripen to black. The small leathery leaves are a useful filler in flower arranging, and very long-lasting. Grow this compact cultivar in sun or part shade; once established, it needs no supplemental water.

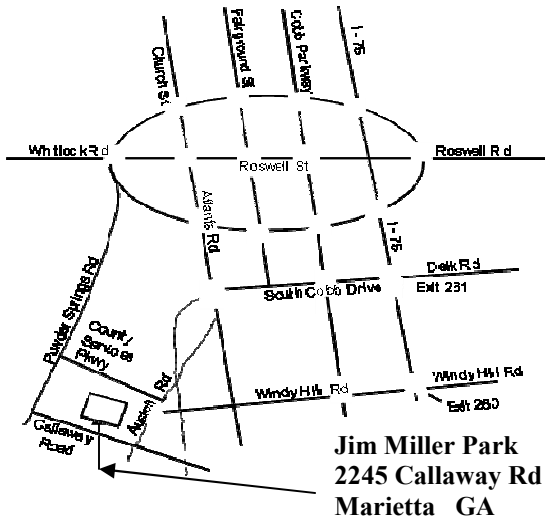
ADMIRAL SEMMES Cost \$ 12.00 2 gal. size.
