<p><b>BLACKBERRY</b> Cost \$ 5.00 1 gallon size</p>  <p>Bushes are self-fruitful. They yield more in full sun but will tolerate some shade. Blackberries are relatively pest free and require little care once established and are not as aggressive as their wild cousins. Expect yields up to 3-4 pints per plant. Thornless varieties: <b>Arapaho</b>; <b>Navaho</b>; and <b>Black Satin</b></p>	<p><b>CRAPE MYRTLE</b> Cost \$ 5.00 1 gallon size</p>  <p>Plants with distinctive exfoliating bark are improved releases from the U.S. Arboretum and have a high resistance to powdery mildew disease. Plants are approximately 1 ft. tall and will grow to 10 to 20 feet depending the variety. <b>Arapaho</b> (deep pink); <b>Natchez</b> (white);</p>
<p><b>BLUEBERRY</b> Cost \$ 10.00 3 gallon size</p>  <p>Bushes prefer full sun, but tolerate some shade. They are relatively pest free and require little care once established. Plant at least two bushes, each a different variety for cross-pollination. Varieties available are:</p> <p><b>Early Season:</b> <b>Austin</b>; <b>Climax</b>; <b>Premier</b>; <b>Vernon</b>;</p> <p><b>Mid Season:</b> <b>Brightwell</b>; <b>Tifblue</b>; <b>Powder Blue</b>;</p> <p><b>Late Season:</b> <b>Centurion</b>; <b>Ochlocknee</b></p>	<p><b>CRAPE MYRTLE</b> Cost \$6.00 1 gallon size <b>Pink Velour</b> (Pink)</p> <p><b>CHRYSANTHA—EDGEWORTHIA</b> Cost \$ 13.00 1 gallon size</p>  <p>The “Paperbush” is a very unusual and uncommon Daphne relative that bears white to bright yellow flowers on bare stems in winter. It is a semi shade plant and grows to 5 feet.</p>
<p><b>RASPBERRY</b> Cost \$ 5.00 1 gallon size</p>  <p>The <b>LATHAM</b> raspberry is large, full flavored and aromatic fruit. It is good for fresh eating, canning, freezing, jams, juice or cobblers and pies.</p>	<p><b>HEUCHERAS</b> Cost \$7.00 1 gallon size</p> <p>Heucheras are perennials with striking foliage and textures.</p> <p><b>Carmel</b>—fuzzy, glowing carmel foliage and purple-red undersides, pinky-cream flowers in midsummer.</p>  <p><b>Plum Pudding</b>—Leaves shiny, silvery, plum-purple with dark purple veining. White blooms in June –July.</p> 
<p><b>FIGS—Celeste</b> Cost \$9.00 3 gallon size</p>  <p>Medium, sweet figs ripening in July. Self pollinating, 15 ft. at maturity. Needs 8 hrs. sun. Insects and diseases not serious problems. Birds are a pest. Enjoy fresh, preserved, dried, canned.</p>	<p><b>LOROPETALUM—Ruby</b> Cost \$6.00 1 gallon size</p>  <p>“Chinese fringe tree” is a 3-5 ft. rounded evergreen shrub. Young leaves ruby red, hot pink flowers in Spring. Plant in sun or dappled shade, in well drained humus rich, slightly acidic soil. A low maintenance border or woodland shrub.</p>
<p><b>ADMIRAL SEMMES</b> Cost \$ 13.00 2 gallon size</p>  <p>Bright yellow, fragrant azalea. This 2007 Georgia Gold Medal plant flourishes in the hot, humid conditions of the South. A large deciduous shrub reported to be free of pests and diseases.</p>

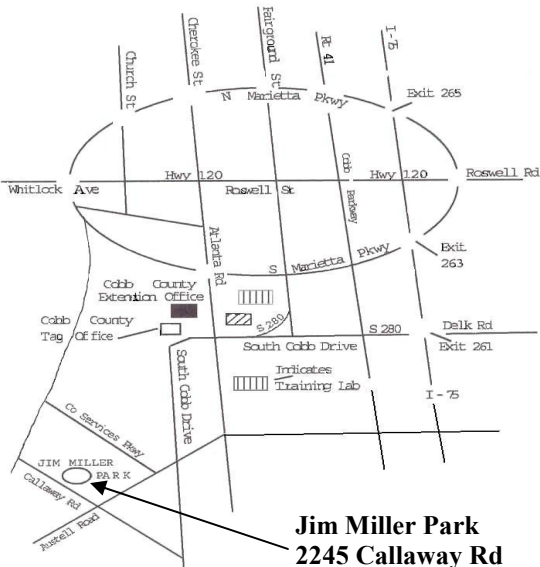
