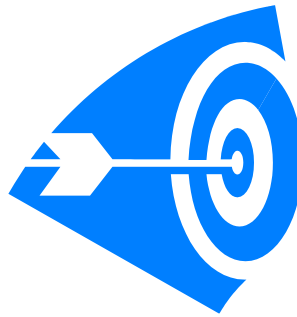

Membership is limited. 4-H is only able to take 20 new 4-H'ers this year. Memberships will be taken with deposit on a first received basis. The fee is non-refundable, make sure this is something you want to commit to before you register. Please read the following information carefully.

How much does it cost to join?

If you do not own your own equipment the activity fee will be \$315.00, (includes equipment, archery workshop class, competitions, practices, and activity fee) which can be paid in (\$105.00) installments with the total due by November 19. Returning members and new members with their own equipment the yearly activity fee is \$160.00

When do we meet?

We are currently taking enrollment for the 4-H Archery Program that **will start in December and run through the 4-H State Archery Tournament at Rock Eagle in May.**

If your child currently owns equipment, we will need to meet very soon to determine if the equipment fits them properly and will be allowed to use their own equipment.

The 4-H office is willing to allow you to make payments on the programs offered, but all equipment must be paid by November 19 to insure that the equipment can be ordered and arrive in time for classes to start.

But What If I Can't Make A Practice?

We realize how busy families are on the weekends and that you may not be able to make all of the practices. Members will not be penalized for missing practices. But also remember, the more practices you attend, the better you will become and the more skill level patches you will receive.

Parents please be prepared to stay with your child during practice. Practices have to be carefully monitored for safety and we want to be sure that your child is not distracted during instruction and practice. By staying you are also learning about the archery program and will be better equipped to supervise and assist your child at home.

What do I get for my membership fee?

Equipment Bow -Internature Bullseye recurve, 48" long, 15# or 20# draw, right or left handed. The coaches will determine ahead of time which poundage and either left hand or right hand.

Arm Guard- either 6" or full length with Velcro straps

Finger tab – leather, either right or left handed determined by coach

Quiver- for arrows

1 dozen Easton Jazz arrows- size will be determined by coach (1516, 1616, 1716)

Arrow rest for bow- determined left or right by the coach

Bow stringer

Targets will be provided

Eligibility to compete in the County and State 4-H Archery Tournament for trophies and ribbons

County winners will advance to the expense paid state competition in the spring at Rock Eagle 4-H Center these participants will receive recognition at the 4-H County Awards program.
