

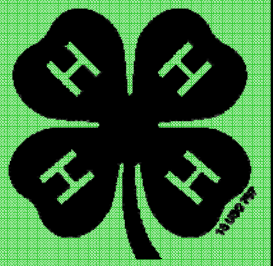

## Trees are Terrific and So are You!

In December, fifth grade students learned how trees provide energy through food and recreation and that the proper placement of trees can help conserve energy by lowering heating and air-conditioning bills. The lessons inspired many students to draw their own interpretation of the lesson and as a result, 174 entries were turned in to the Arbor Day Poster Contest. Six elementary schools participated and we want to thank the teachers that encouraged their students, providing materials and class time to complete their artwork. Brooks Elementary submitted the largest number of posters: 44 entries in all. White Oak submitted 104 entries outside of 4-H.
