# 4-H State Council Dress Code

A person's dress should be in good taste and should not be a distraction to others.  
Keep in mind these specific guidelines in mind for each activity:

<b>General Clothing Tips</b>	Clothing should be clean, pressed and in good taste. Clothing should be free of holes, frays and tears. No clothing alluding to violations in the 4-H Code of Conduct are allowed. Undergarments should be worn but not be visible. Midriffs should not be exposed and pajama bottoms may not be worn in the place of pants.
<b>Friday</b>	Comfortable, modest dress including shorts, t-shirts, tennis shoes and sandals.
<b>All Day Saturday</b>	Comfortable modest dress including shorts and tennis shoes. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times except in water activities. Bathing suits may be worn for water activities only. Bathing suits should be one piece suits and cover-ups and/or shirts must be worn over bathing suits when not in water. Appropriate footwear must be worn for Iron Clover activities. For example, tennis shoes must be worn for Iron Clover events that involve running such as softball, relays, etc.
<b>Sunday All Day</b>	Better school clothes including pants, collared shirts, skirts, capri pants and other better dress wear. No shorts, jeans, tennis shoes, or t-shirts.
