There are new and better plants all the time. Come see what these are and how they can improve your landscape.

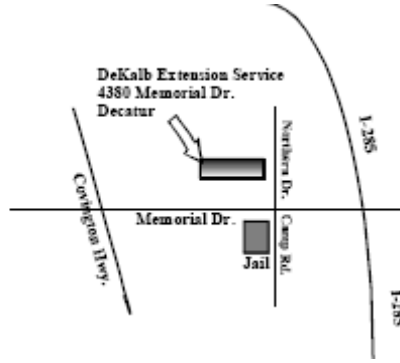

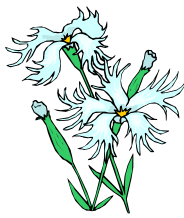
FALL Lawn Care

Know your grass and make wise decisions!

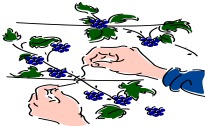


Flowers That Work

The sky's the limit; don't ignore whatever available space you have. Many plants trail, vine, and provide interest at various times of the year.

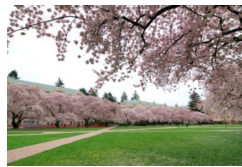


Improve Your Home's Curb Appeal
