### Kiwanis Ogeechee Fair

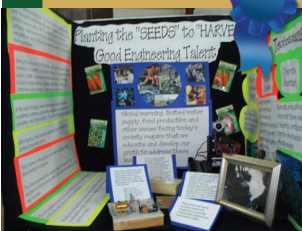

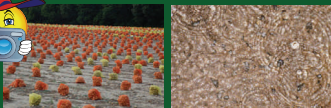
