

Evergreen Azaleas



Hershey Red Azalea

Medium size red double flowers. Glossy medium size dark green leaves. Grows as wide as it does tall and is a medium grower. It blooms March-May, and grows to 4' wide in 10 years. This is also an evergreen azalea, and has the same growing conditions as Fashion and Coral Bells variety.



Girard's Rose Azalea

Azalea x 'Girard's Rose' (Girard hybrid)

Reliable crop of single, deep rose red blooms on well proven variety. Heavy bloomer offers color for weeks in spring. Produces a compact, branched mound for a tidy landscape shrub. Well sized for most residential applications. An exceptional foundation plant and seasonal color for Japanese garden. Mid-season. Prefers acidic soil. Semi-evergreen shrub. Full to partial sun. Moderate growth 3 feet tall, 3 feet wide.

Long-blooming Azalea has large soft-pink flowers with rose-pink overtones and is cold hardy.

Height: 12 in, Width: 3 ft - 4 ft. Bloom season: Summer, Bloom color: Pink, Rose; Plant in Full Sun, Part Shade

Lavender

Flower single, 2 1/2" to 3" across, fragrant, moderate purplish pink with a dark red blotch.

Bloom Time: Early Midseason
