Learning for Life

Payment of camp can be divided into three installments. A deposit of \$100.00 along with this application is DUE on **February 20, 2012**; a second installment of \$100.00 is DUE by **March 20, 2012**, and the balance of \$100.00 is DUE by **April 20, 2012**.

Should you discover that your child is unable to attend after submitting the entire camp cost of \$300.00, you must contact our office at 706-629-8685 immediately. If we are unable to find a replacement to fill your child's spot, \$140.00 will be non-refundable.

This is a long way from home; who will be watching my child?

Your child along with other Gordon County 4-H'ers will be chaperoned by two Gordon County 4-H Staff members, adult volunteers and 4-H teen leader. Once we all arrive, the Rock Eagle 4-H Camp Staff consisting of Counselors, other county 4-H Staff, and State 4-H Staff will be on hand. The Counselors are certified lifeguards and CPR certified as well. There is also a registered nurse on-site at all times. Rock Eagle has an adult to youth ratio of three adults to ten youth. (3:10).

Describe the camp facilities.

Rock Eagle 4-H Center is the largest 4-H camp in the United States. It is located north of Eatonton, Georgia, adjacent to the Oconee National Forest. With nearly 1,500 acres of forested land, including a 110 acre lake, Rock Eagle is a natural meeting site away from everyday life.

The camp can house a total of up to 1,000 campers and adults. In each cabin there are adult sleeping quarters. There are no co-ed cabins; girls, along with female chaperones, will be housed in separate cabins from boys with their male chaperones. Each child will have their own bed.

There will be three meals prepared each day. The dining hall, auditorium, pavilions and meeting areas are all centrally located.
