## Show Rules/Awards

Show Safety Policy:

Unruly riders, spectators, horses or dogs will be dismissed from show grounds.

**DIVISION HIGH POINT AND RESERVE:** Hunter, (classes 1-7) Beginner (classes 22-25) English Youth, English Open, Western Youth, and Western Open. Showmanship classes count toward division high point. Points accumulate on horse /rider combination.

**BEGINNER:** Any rider with limited riding experience. **No green horses in beginner division, only green riders!** In addition to their Division, Beginners are allowed in Cross Rails (8), Halter or Showmanship (10, 26, 27, 28, and 29) Beginners are NOT allowed in any other classes for safety reasons.

**NON- BLUE CLASSES:** Haven't placed first in a previous show. Honor system! Does not count toward any High Point.

**YOUTH:** High school seniors or younger. **OPEN:** Any age-Youth and Adults welcome.

**4-H CLASSES:** Open to current 4-H members of any grade from any club. Leader's name and county of membership may be asked. NO BEGINNERS. Does not count toward any High Point.

### **GREEN HORSE:**

Horses should have no experience, or be in their first year of showing. No beginner riders.

ASTM Helmets are required for all English and Fun classes. Helmets are recommended for all other riders of all ages. No penalty in Western Division for helmet. Boots with heels must be worn in all classes. Proper English and Western attire required for all related divisions. Jackets may be waived at the discretion of the judge. Please tie a red ribbon on horses that kick! No stallions will be allowed. No alcoholic beverages anywhere on the show property. Dogs must be leashed.

**DIRECTIONS:** Georgia International Horse Park 1996 Centennial Olympic Parkway Conyers, GA 30013 From Highway 138, follow parkway and signs for Arenas 8 and 9. It is located near the RV lot. Look for Gwinnett 4-H signs.

### **SHAVINGS:**

All stalls must use 2 bags of shavings. Please arrange for your own shavings. Bring your own or call and order by credit card through Queen Shavings 770-860-9111 or 678-416-1424. Shavings also available at Queen Shavings building on grounds.

**FEES:** Stall fee \$25. Ground Fee, (tie to trailer) \$20. Office Fee \$5.00 per horse/rider combo. Class discount for pre-registration.

All classes \$6.00 with pre -registration All classes \$8.00 day of show
