



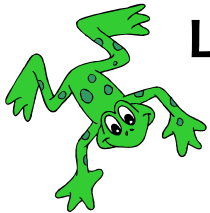
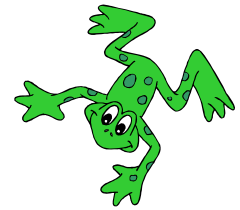
# ROCK EAGLE 4-H CAMP

(Based on grade just completed in school)

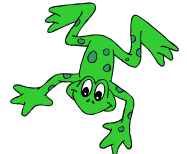

Leap into some summer fun! Join us at 4-H Camp at the State 4-H Center - Rock Eagle.

Camp is open to 4<sup>th</sup> grade and 5<sup>th</sup> grade girls and boys. Rock Eagle is just 1½ hours from Gwinnett County.



Here are the details for 2012 Camp:

1. Registration begins now until April 1<sup>st</sup>. **Cost for camp will be \$300.00.** Payment must be made in full when application is mailed or brought to the office. Spaces are filled on a first come, first served basis. If you need to pay in 3 monthly installments, please contact the 4-H Office for information at 678-377-4010 and ask to speak with Pam. **Installments will only be made for applications received by April 1<sup>st</sup>.**
2. There is a \$75.00 cancellation fee until June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. No refunds after June 1<sup>st</sup>. Returned checks will be charged an additional fee of \$30.00.
3. Transportation is included in camp fees. Departure will be from Gwinnett County Fairgrounds in Lawrenceville and will return to same.
4. Camp accommodations are air-conditioned cabins that accommodate 18 campers per cabin. Adult cabin chaperones are 4-H staff members, or certified volunteers, occupying the leader's quarters in each cabin. A medical facility is available 24 hours a day.
5. Campers are assigned classes and are age appropriate and fun. All campers participate in water games, classes and special evening events. All swimming is highly supervised in the pool. Rock Eagle has a water slide that is a highlight of the camping week.
6. Each camper is a 4-H'er when attending camp and will follow the 4-H Code of Conduct. It will be strictly enforced and should be read with your child before leaving for camp.
7. Details about cabin assignments, what to bring, departure times and bus numbers will be distributed at "Questions and Answers - Camp Night" meeting. Campers and parents can ask questions, meet our camping staff, and learn more about your child's week of fun. A letter or email will be sent to remind you of the date and time.
