



Things to know about Jackson County 4-H Archery Program 2011-2012

- Must be a 4-H'er in between the ages of 9 and 19.
- Activity Fee: \$60.00 per year - covers insurance, entry fees for State Match, targets, T-shirt, miscellaneous supplies. Activity Fee Due before 1st practice. Please pay at the 4-H office and not at practice. Pay at the Extension Office or mail to: Jackson County 4-H, P.O. Box 760, Jefferson, GA 30549
- Participants are encouraged to purchase their own equipment including bow, arrows, arm guard, finger protection and quiver. We have a few recurve bows, but no compound bows available for students to use during first practices.
- Regular attendance at practice is expected. We know that occasionally you may need to miss a practice. Practices will be held every Saturday at the Jackson County Recreation Department from 3:30-5:00 p.m. (no practice Nov. 26, December 24 or 31st)
- The first practice for veteran shooters will be January 7th, 2012.

Additional Cost:

- T-shirts for parents and other family members @ \$12.00 each
- Meals and Lodging at State Match for parents and siblings attending @ approximately \$40.00 each
- Equipment—bows and arrows and accessories (Can be purchased at a discount through Jackson County 4-H)

Distances for State Competition

Total highest possible score in FITA is 360 points for all age classes.

•Compound:

•Seniors: two ends of six arrows each at 60, 50, 40 meters

•Juniors: two ends of six arrows each at 50, 40, 30 meters

•Cloverleaves: two ends of six arrows each at 40, 30, 20 meters

•Recurve:

•Seniors: two ends of six arrows each at 60, 50, 40 meters

•Juniors: two ends of six arrows each at 50, 40, 30 meters

•Cloverleaves: two ends of six arrows each at 10,20,30 meters

•Novice Class: Cloverleaves only, two ends of six arrows each at 10,20,30 meters: 36 total arrows

The 3-D archery event and field round will count towards senior total tournament score. Juniors and Cloverleaves are encouraged to participate in the 3D course but that score will not be included in the match.
