REGISTRATION INFORMATION

How do I register? Registration for the 2011 Lamar County 4-H Summer Program is on-going. We will accept registrations for activities up to **4 days before** the activity. Registration will be held at the Lamar County Extension office, located at 118 Academy Drive, Suite A. Parents may register their children from 8:00 a.m. - noon and from 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. Activities have a limited enrollment and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Please bring the registration form and your payment to the office when you register your child. PHONE REGISTRATIONS FOR **FREE** ACTIVITIES WILL BE TAKEN OVER THE PHONE.

What does it cost? The cost varies for each activity. The fees include insurance, transportation (if applicable) and material costs. The fee is due when you come to register your child for summer activities.

What about payment? Fees for all classes may be paid by cash or check. Please make checks payable to Lamar County 4-H.

Are there any forms needed? Apart from the registration form, a Medical Information and Release form must be completed for each child participating in Lamar County 4-H summer activities. A Code of Conduct form must be on file for every 4-H'er that attends an activity as well.

What about transportation? A number of out of town field trips have been planned for the summer. Transportation for these trips will be provided by Lamar County Extension. However, you are responsible for transporting your child to and from the Lamar County Extension office.

What about chaperones? All activities will be chaperoned by Lamar County Extension staff and/or parent volunteer leaders. If you are interested in serving as a chaperone, you must complete a volunteer leader application and go through a screening process conducted by the University of Georgia. Please contact the 4-H office as soon as possible if you would like to assist with or chaperone an activity.

What is the cancellation policy? All the activities for the 2011 Lamar County 4-H Summer Program have been allotted a minimum number of participants per activity. If this number is not met, the activity will be canceled. If a class is canceled, registered participants will be notified.

What is the refund policy? Registration fees are not refundable unless an activity is canceled. Please notify us immediately if you are unable to attend an activity.

4-H QUIZ BOWL & JUDGING TEAMS

We are looking for 4-H'ers to participate in 4-H quiz bowls and judging events!

Forestry Judging: You identify trees, insects, and diseases while also gaining an understanding of how forests affect our lives. You also learn to use a compass and to cruise timber. Practices for the Forestry Judging Team will be held July – September. The competition will be held in September. This activity is for 6th – 12th grade 4-H'ers!

Cotton Boll and Consumer Judging: Do you like to shop and find the best value for your money? Then this event is for you. You will learn about cotton and to make good purchasing decisions. Practices for the Cotton Boll and Consumer Judging Team will be held late September – November. The competition will be held in November. This activity is for 5th – 12th grade 4-H'ers!

Horse Quiz Bowl: You will have fun learning about horses in this team competition that tests your knowledge of horses against 4-H'ers around the state of Georgia! Practices for the Horse Quiz Bowl competition will be held November – January. The competition will be held in January. This activity is for 5th – 12th grade 4-H'ers!

Dairy Quiz Bowl: You will have fun learning about those cows that provide us with moo-verlous milk! Not only that, you will also learn about milk quality, herd health, dairy foods, calf raising and much more! Then, you will test your knowledge of dairy cows against 4-H'ers around the state of Georgia! Practices for the Horse Quiz Bowl competition will be held late January – April. This activity is for 5th – 12th grade 4-H'ers!

Poultry Judging: This is a hands-on contest where you will learn how to candle eggs, study the anatomy of chickens, grade eggs and much more!
