Lanier County 4-H is looking for volunteers!

Below is a description of the various volunteer roles:

- **Over-Night Chaperone**- Chaperone 4-H'ers on overnight trips. Overnight trips are mainly to Rock Eagle for Fall Forum and Junior Conference. Junior Conference is for 7th-8th grade 4-H'ers and is held the first weekend of November. Fall Forum is for 9th-12th grade 4-H'ers and is the second weekend of December. Lanier County 4-H also attend 4-H events at the Capital in Atlanta and in January we are attending at hockey game in Atlanta! *In order to make the Hockey Game possible we need over-night chaperones!*
- **Driver**- The Lanier County 4-H van can hold no more than 10 people. Sometimes volunteers are needed to help transport 4-H'ers when there are more than 10 4-H'ers participating in an out of town event usually to Tifton for judging events or to Lowndes County for multi county events.
- **Judging Team Coach**- There are 8 judging team opportunities offered: Cotton Boll Consumer Jamboree , Poultry Judging , Horse Judging, Land Judging, Wildlife Judging, Forestry Judging, Livestock Judging, and Dairy Judging
- **Day trip chaperone**- This would include UGA football games!
- **Project club leader** To help youth develop life skills and help youth learn skills and information about a specific project. Plan and prepare for project meetings or workshops, which utilize experiential learning through workshops, field trips, audio/video resources, guest speakers, teaching kits, computers, or other learning tools. Coordinate these activities with the club leader for club level activities or Extension staff for county level activities.
- **Office Helper** - help make copies, fold brochures , assemble packets etc.
