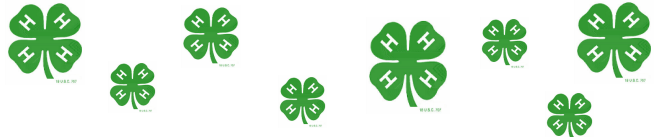

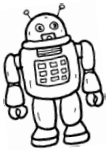


Horse Club
