



County Project Achievement

County Project Achievement or CPA, for short, may seem a little complicated but it is not. Remember Show and Tell? Well DPA is very similar. 4-H'ers pick a subject they know about or would like to learn and then write a short report, approximately 2 pages, on that subject.

All of these reports will be judged and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will be invited to compete at District Project Achievement. As the name implies DPA is a larger competition. This competition will be March 15, 2008 in Ashburn, GA. For DPA the cloverleaf 4-H'ers will convert their reports into a speech and add some visual aids. To assist the 4-H'ers and parents with converting the report into a speech the 4-H staff will conduct two parent meetings. At these meetings the 4-H'ers and parents will get to see an actual demonstration, find out what to expect the day of competition and be able to ask questions.
