Monroe County S.A.F.E. Shotgun Team Information for 2012 Season

Parent/ Adult Please fill out & sign pink & blue forms-due by first practice

Students fill out 4-H Enrollment form

Registration fee of \$65.00 due by first practice-check made payable to: Monroe Co. 4-H

Shell fee of \$7.00-9.00 will be due for each practice-payable as noted above-you are welcome to pay monthly if that works best for you.

Practice is held on Sundays and **begins** @ 2:00-please arrive early. Upon arrival at practice, please place your shotgun in the stand, students sign-in & pay fee due for the day, please help with set-up. We ask that all 4-H'ers plan to stay afterwards to clean-up shell casings and put away equipment.

The first practice will be held on January 22rd.

Hunter safety certification course must be completed with card in hand by February 26th practice

Dress for the weather, **no open toe shoes**, use ear & eye protection. We will have some or you can provide. Bring a chair.

Each 4-H'er will shoot 1 round of 25 at each practice from an automatic thrower.

Junior team members-7th & 8th graders

Senior team members-9th-12th graders (or if 18 by January 1st)

The season runs from January 22-April 21st. If 4-H'er qualifies for State season continues to May 12th.

Important dates:

Saturday April 21st, 2012(tentative)-Qualifying for State competition @ Griffin Gun Club in Spalding County. In order to qualify to go on to State competition:

Jr team members must hit 16 clays out of 25

Sr team members must hit 20 clays out of 25

Saturday May 12, 2012-State contest for all team members that qualified according to guidelines listed above-held near Rock Eagle

If any other opportunities for "non-4-H" shoots come up I will e-mail you with the information. These will be on your own and at your expense.

If there is incimate weather conditions (heavy rain, extreme wind or lightning) the coaches will call team members by 12:30 to call off practice.
