

Morgan County Extension Agent wins Animal Science Programming Award

Bobby Smith, Morgan County Cooperative Extension- Ag and Natural Resources Agent, recently won the Animal Science Programming Award for Excellence in Livestock Education at the Georgia Association of County Agriculture Agents (GACAA) Annual Meeting and Professional Improvement Conference held in Athens.

Bobby received first place in this State Award for his Animal Science programming efforts. Smith was recognized for his contributions in educational programming including the Fall Reproductive Management Workshops in English and Spanish, a Mastitis and Milk Quality Workshop in English and Spanish, and 3 UGA Livestock Publications: "*Georgia Forages: Grass Species*," *Improving Artificial Insemination Techniques*, and *Dairy Judging Terminology*." Smith also is active in 4-H Livestock programs for youth.
