WHEN: Wednesday, February 15 **Limit:15**

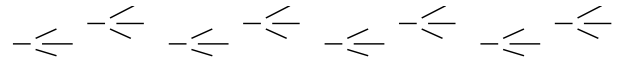
WHERE: Drop off/ Pick up-4-H center

Poultry Judging Kick-Off!!

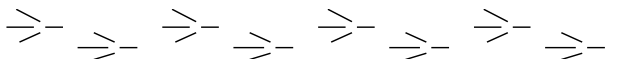
