HOW DO I REGISTER?

You may begin to sign up for summer activities as soon as you receive your booklet. Bring the registration form and money for each activity by the 4-H office located at 103 East Church Street in Cuthbert, or mail it to us at P. O. Box 282, Cuthbert, GA 39840.

WHAT'S THE COST?

The cost varies for each activity. The fee includes insurance and transportation. The fee is due when you send in your registration form. Please make your check payable to Randolph County 4-H.

WHAT ABOUT LATE REGISTRATION?

All activities have a limited enrollment and will be filled on a first-come, first served basis.

WHAT IF I CAN'T GO?

Registration fees are not refundable unless an activity is either canceled or filled to capacity.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SIGN UP?

We will send you a reminder and further information about the classes that you register for.

WHAT ABOUT TRANSPORTATION?

Unless otherwise noted, all transportation to and from activities outside of the 4-H office will be provided by Mrs. Kris, Ms. Kimberly, and Volunteer Leaders. You are responsible for your own transportation to and from the 4-H office before and after classes.

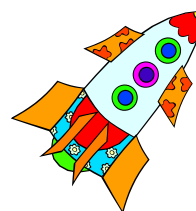

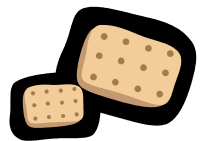

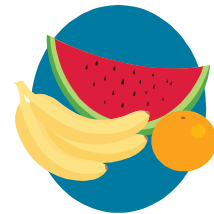

The following items can be made this summer during summer classes. Mrs. Kris will deliver these items and then pick them up at the end of the fair. All you will have to do is make the item, complete it and have it to the 4-H office by Tuesday, September 29th There is prize money for placing 1-10. The items are to be made at home and delivered to the 4-H office before the fair begins are:

- < **Mini-booth Exhibits**- two boards giving information based on a subject (Cl, Jr, Sr)
- < **4-H Inventions**- can be made of tin cans, wood or almost anything, must be your idea (Cl, Jr., Sr.)
- < **4-H Recycling**- help promote an environmentally safe world. Paper, cans, glass (Cl., Jr., Sr.)
- < **Decorated Agricultural Product Exhibits**- use your imaginations and create a masterpiece. Categories: (story book character, seasonal holidays, animals, other) (Cl., Jr., Sr.)
- < **Terrarium/Dish Garden Exhibit**- select your plants for interest, variety and suitability. Place in container to create a pretty garden. (Cl., Jr.)

Omelet Contest- Make your own omelet from your secret ingredients. Saturday, October 10th 9:00 a.m.- Juniors and 10:30-Seniors-individuals or team of two

Homemade Ice Cream Contest- Team up with a 4-H friend or do it all. Bring your best recipe and prepare your great tasting ice cream. Saturday, October 17th 10:00 a.m. (Cloverleaves, Junior and Seniors)

Wild Game Dish- Cook your wild game (dove, deer, quail, and squirrel) Sunday, October 11th 12:30 Juniors and Senior-individual or team of two
