

~ HOW TO EARN POINTS ~

Listed below are different ways to earn points for you and your class and the point value for each activity.

FAIR SERVICE

5 points For each shift you and a parent work at the 4-H Food Booth. 4-H member must work with a parent to earn points. (Only 5 points per 4-H member per shift – not 5 points per person). (Maximum of 100 points).

FAIR ENTRY

3 points For each exhibit entered with a maximum of 51 points possible.

HELPING HANDS

5 points For each helping hands project you do. Your name must be checked off on the poster in your classroom as participating. (Maximum of 100 points). This is for 4-H or School helping hands projects.

SCHOOL PROJECT ACHIEVEMENT

20 points Creating and presenting a demonstration.

AREA PROJECT ACHIEVEMENT

30 points Present your demonstration at the area competition in Douglasville, GA.

T-SHIRT DESIGN

10 points For turning in an entry for the stream cleanup t-shirt design contest. Details will be given during your class meeting.

WATER SURVEY

10 points Return the completed 4-H Water Survey and receive 10 points. Details will be given during your class meeting.

FRIENDS BOOKS

10 points For each Friends book completed and returned to 4-H.

JUDGING TEAMS

8 points For participating in and attending the competition on a Judging Team. (example: Consumer, Wildlife, Poultry, Horse Quiz Bowl)

PROJECT CLUB

10 points For participating in a special interest club. (Dog, Horse, S.A.F.E., Edible Clovers or Quilting)
Points are awarded for *EACH* club in which you participate.
