General Information

Camp is open to students currently in 4th-6th grades. The camp will be held Monday-Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Agriculture Building on Vulcan Road. Campers may be dropped off as early as 7:30 a.m. and must be picked up no later than 5:30 p.m. Campers will need to bring a sack lunch except on days when lunch is provided. Snacks will be provided.

Activities

This camp focuses on activities in the areas of science, engineering, and technology (SET). Each day campers will experience two SET workshops. They will also participate in a Health Rocks workshop, which teaches youth how to stay healthy, handle stress, and strategies to stay away from drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. Plenty of recreation time with games, snacks, and crafts will be held in between each of these workshops. In addition, 4-H'ers will have the option to attend a Special Interest Workshop each day. 4-H'ers must sign-up for this workshop at registration. Those that do not participate in the Special Interest workshop will attend arts and crafts. We will end the week with a day trip to Callaway Gardens.

Cost

The cost for the week of camp is \$20. This includes all supplies, activities, snacks, any meals provided, and a trip to Callaway Gardens.

Registration

Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis. We have 30 spots available for the week.
