The Troup County 4-H Office is offering Cloverleaf, 5th and 6th grade 4-Hers an opportunity to participate in a Milkmake Contest. This is a fun and educational event that will develop skills in food preparation.

Milkmake is a 4-H Food, Nutrition and Health Activity that is educational, fun and will add a creative twist to their daily intake of milk. They will also learn more about the nutritional value and versatility of milk. 4-Hers will create a milk drink that is edible. The milk drink will be judged using the Georgia 4-H Milk Make Contest Score Card. A recipe should list all the ingredients and amount used the number of servings and direction for making the drink.

There will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner from each 4-H participating school. Entries are due to 4-H Agent Julie Kennedy or Program Assistant Elizabeth Thornton no later than January 28.
