Youth Contests

General Rules

1. The contests are open to youth in grades 4-12 in Harris, Meriwether, and Troup Counties.
2. There are two divisions in each category. The top 3 entries in each division will receive ribbons for their category.
 - Division I: 4th-8th Grades
 - Division II: 9th-12th Grades
3. All entries MUST be the work of the exhibitor.
4. Contest entries must be delivered to your County Extension Office by 5pm on Friday, September 9. Entries may be picked up after the fair on Monday September 19 from your Extension Office.
5. Exhibitors may only enter one item in each category.
6. An entry form must be completed by each exhibitor and should be turned in with entries.
7. Covered Bridge Days and Butts Mill Farms are not responsible for the loss or damage of any items entered in the contests.
8. Each exhibitor will receive 2 free passes to the Covered Bridge Days festival

CONTEST CATEGORIES

Photography Contest

All photo entries must be mounted on 8" x 10" cardboard/cardstock. The exhibitors name, address, and phone number should be written on the back along with a title for the image. Entries will be judged based on composition, focus, lighting, and subject matter.

Recycling Contest

Recycle household items to create something new that either serves a function or is decorative. Include a 5 x 7" index card that tells what your item is and what it is made from. Entries will be judged on originality and overall appearance.

Decorated Agricultural Products

Use agricultural products to design and create unique works of art. No perishable products may be used. Entries will be judged on originality and overall appearance.

Minibooths

4-H Winners in this category will have an opportunity to compete at the Georgia National Fair in Perry. Exhibitors will create a mini-booth that shares information on any appropriate topic as chosen by the exhibitor. The mini-booth should present factual, educational information about your topic. The mini booth should consist of a two-sided display board with each panel measuring 30" x 24". When open the span should not exceed 36". Display items can be placed on the table in the space between the two sides as seen in the example below. Electricity will not be provided. Entries will be judged on how effectively the message is presented, quality of construction, and accuracy of information.
