Poultry Judging

Practices for the poultry judging contest will begin March 2nd after school and will run until about 5:00pm. There will be about two practices a week until the contest on April 22 in Tifton. Poultry Judging involves looking at live birds, egg quality (both exterior and interior), ready-to-cook poultry and parts identification. If you would like to be part of this years Poultry Judging team please call Ms. Laura at the County Extension office (828-2325) so you will be notified of the requirements and schedule.

Cloverleaf Camp

This year cloverleaf camp will be at Rock Eagle, near Eatonton, from Monday, June 15-Friday, June 19th. The camp will be open for current 4th, 5th and 6th graders. Cost for cloverleaf camp will be \$260. This fee includes transportation to and from camp, all meals, lodging, activities and insurance. If you would like to sign up for camp you will need to bring \$100 non-refundable deposit by the 4-H office to reserve your slot by March 13th at 5:00 pm.

Junior Camp

Junior 4-H'ers will be camping at Fortson 4-H Center from Monday, June 22- Friday, June 26th. This camp will be open for current 7th and 8th graders. The activities at Camp Fortson will include White Water Park, a day at Stone Mountain (including Sky Hike-rope course, 3D theater, sky buckets to the top of the mountain and a train ride), Thursday Night Thunder at the Atlanta Motor Speedway, a Pizza Party and a souvenir t-shirt and tote bag. The camp cost will be \$305. This fee includes all activities, transportation to and from camp, meals, lodging and insurance. If you would like to sign up for Junior Camp you will need to bring \$100 non-refundable deposit by the 4-H office to reserve your slot by March 6th at 5:00pm.

Senior Camp

This year Senior camp will be held at Wahsega 4-H Center from Monday, June 29- Friday, July 3rd. This will include current 9th - 12th grade students. The cost for Senior Camp will be \$315. This fee includes the cost of speakers and socials, a night out in Downtown Dahlonega, a Karaoke Party, a trip to Helen for shopping, tubing and other water fun and a souvenir t-shirt. If you are interested in attending Senior camp you will need to bring \$100 non-refundable deposit by the 4-H office to reserve your slot by March 13th at 5:00pm.
